World War Ii Ration Books 1943 45 Welcome Indiana - Sugar, the first item rationed nationwide in May 1942, started the process, followed by coffee. People lined up at public places staffed by volunteers who took depositions on how much sugar each family already had at home and then issued ration books containing coupons good for a year's supply. Rationing for the War Effort. Ask anyone who remembers life on the Home Front during World War II about their strongest memories and chances are they will tell you about rationing. You see, the war caused shortages of all sorts of things: rubber, metal, clothing, etc. Four different series of war ration books were issued. In 1942, five months after (December 8, 1941) the United States entered the Second World War, " Book One " series were issued. In January 1943, " Book Two " series were issued.
